

## Water Stain Removal

Oxalic acid can be used to bleach unfinished wood that has been water stained.

Oxalic acid is a poisonous strong organic acid used especially as a bleaching or cleaning agent. Read manufacturer's instructions and application procedures carefully before using. **CAUTION: use eye and hand protection.**

It can be purchased at hardware, drug, or grocery outlets.

### Application Procedures:

1. Mix approximately 2 tablespoons of oxalic acid to 8 ounces of water in a pan.
2. Dampen sponge
3. Stroke lightly on affected surface.
4. If the affected area is not completely bleached in the first application, let the area dry completely and then reapply the acid.

## Mildew Removal

### USE EYE AND HAND PROTECTION

1. Use equal amounts of bleach to water.
2. Dampen sponge.
3. Stroke lightly on the affected surface – Do Not Rub.
4. If the affected area is not completely bleached in the first application, let dry completely and then reapply.
