

Water Stain Removal

Oxalic acid can be used to bleach unfinished wood that has been water stained.

Oxalic acid is a poisonous strong organic acid used especially as a bleaching or cleaning agent. Read manufacturer's instructions and application procedures carefully before using. **CAUTION: use eye and hand protection.**

It can be purchased at hardware, drug, or grocery outlets.

Application Procedures:

- 1. Mix approximately 2 tablespoons of oxalic acid to 8 ounces of water in a pan.
- 2. Dampen sponge
- 3. Stroke lightly on affected surface.
- 4. If the affected area is not completely bleached in the first application, let the area dry completely and then reapply the acid.

Mildew Removal

USE EYE AND HAND PROTECTION

- 1. Use equal amounts of bleach to water.
- 2. Dampen sponge.
- 3. Stroke lightly on the affected surface Do Not Rub.
- 4. If the affected area is not completely bleached in the first application, let dry completely and then reapply.
