


KD Ultimate Sliding Patio Door

Assembly Instructions




BEFORE YOU BEGIN

IMPORTANT! Read these instructions thoroughly before beginning to assemble your KD (knocked down) Ultimate Sliding Patio Door. In addition, after assembly is completed, it is important to follow the installation instructions provided. Failure to assemble per assembly instructions will void any warranty, written or implied.

CAUTION: Large door units may require more than one person to assemble the unit. Adequate help for the size of unit being assembled is required.

WARNING: Practice safety! Wear safety glasses or goggles when assembling a Marvin window or door product.

ASSEMBLING THE DOOR FRAME


1. Lay the vertical jambs, head jamb and sill on a flat, level surface exterior cladding facing down.
2. Apply the sill gasket to bottom of the sill as shown. Fill the open areas of the gasket with sealant, making sure no voids are left uncovered. See illustration 1.



3. Now connect the jamb with the sill. Ensure the interior side of the jamb is completely butted against the sill. See illustration 2.

NOTE: To prevent water leaks, be certain the jamb is aligned with the sill liner and butted against the sill.


4. Drill 1" (25) through the predrilled hole in the sill liner into the jamb with a 3/32" drill bit. Fasten the sill liner to the jamb with a #8 X 1 1/2" Phillips pan head screw "F". See illustration 2. **For three wide units**, an additional screw is applied through the sill liner into center jamb.




5. Using the predrilled holes in the sill, drill through the sill and into the wood portion of the side jamb, approximately 3" (76) with a 3/32" drill bit. Beginning with the hole closest to the sill liner, fasten the sill to the side jamb with #8 X 3" Phillips **pan head** screws "E". Fasten the sill to the jamb metal with #8 X 1 1/2" Phillips flat head screw "C".

NOTE: For three wide units follow step 8. For two wide and four wide units, skip to step 9.

6. **For 3 wide units** predrill with a 3/32" drill bit into the center jamb and mull casing through the holes in the sill and apply sealant. Fasten the sill to the center jamb with three #8X3" pan head screws "E". See illustration 3.




7. Add clear sealant at the top of the clad jamb. See illustration 4.




8. Insert the clad frame corner key "D" into the head jamb. Fasten the corners of the head jamb cladding to side jamb through the predrilled holes using #8X1 1/2" Phillips flat head screws "C". See illustration 5.

9. Attach head jamb to side jambs using #7X2" flat head screws "A". Attach side jamb to head jamb using #7X2" flat head screws "A". See illustration 5. Repeat for the second jamb.




NOTE: For three wide units follow step 12. For two and four wide units skip to step 14.


- For **three wide units** install the longest exterior clad head jamb part stop on the non- interlocking panel frame. Align the center jamb up against the head jamb and fasten through the predrilled holes with 3 #7 x 2" flat head screws "A". See illustration 6.



- If applicable, apply nailing fin at this time. With help, stand frame up to vertical position. For ease of assembly temporarily install unit into opening and fasten the top corners to structure.
- Seal joint between sill and jamb with 1/8" bead of sealant. See illustration 7a. Beginning underneath the sill weather strip, place a 3/16" bead of sealant between the end of the sill and jamb weather strip. Continue the bead of sealant toward end of bulb as shown in illustration 7b.



- Apply a bead of sealant from the bottom of the sill vertically along the wood/clad seam, approximately 8- 10" (203- 254). Sealant must adhere to the Ultrex and wood/clad seam. See illustration 8a. Cover sealant with 2" masking tape to avoid contamination. See illustration 8b.




INSTALLING INTERLOCKING STATIONARY PANEL


WARNING: Large door units may be very heavy and awkward to handle. It is important to obtain adequate assistance to avoid injury when handling the unit.

NOTE: For four wide units, follow steps 16-20 for the first stationary panel and then repeat these steps for the second stationary panel.


- Fasten 3 (4 on 8-0) side jamb brackets to the jamb side of the interlock panel through the predrilled holes with "M" #7x1 1/4" flat head screws. See illustration 9a.
- Through predrilled holes fasten stationary head jamb bracket to the interlock panel with "H" #8x1" flat head screws. For placement of the screws see illustration 9b.




16. From the interior, place the interlocking stationary panel 6" away from the jamb at an approx. 75 degree angle. See illustration 10.




17. Push the bottom of the panel outward and gradually tilt panel to the upright position. Press the panel outward ensuring that the flange on the panel leveling block has fully seated into the sill clip and slide panel to the side jamb. See illustration 11.




18. Fasten the interlock side jamb brackets to the side jamb (or center jamb) with "L" #7x5/8" flat head screws. See illustration 12.




19. Use a stiff putty knife to bend the head jamb bracket into place. See illustration 13. Fasten the head jamb bracket to the head jamb with two "H" #8x1" flat head screws placed at a 45° angle. See illustration 13.




20. Install active panel exterior clad head jamb part stop up tight against the head jamb followed by the sill jamb part stop. See illustration 14.



21. Insert condensation dust block end under interlock and slide into place. Tap until seated with a wood block and rubber mallet. See illustration 15.




22. On interlocking stationary panels, start at the interior edge of the Ultrex sill jamb joint and apply a 3/16" to 1/4" bead of sealant towards the stationary panel and up 8-10" (203- 254) along the panel/jamb seam. See illustration 16. Apply to interlocking side of the center jamb if working with XOO or OOX configurations.




23. Attach wood interior stationary jamb cover(s). See illustration 17. Install wood interior jamb liner, bevel side towards panel.

NOTE: Four wide units will not have a jamb liner.




24. Place the sill bumper block against stationary jamb. Mark the drill bit at 1 1/4" (32) to ensure you will not drill through the base of the sill. Using the hole in the bumper block, predrill into the sill using a 3/32" drill bit. Fasten with #8 X 1 1/2" pan head screw "F". **Do not drill through the bottom layer of the sill.** Apply rubber bumper to the end of the bumper block. See illustration 18.

NOTE: The top bumper will be secured after the operating panel has been installed. This will be covered in the Ultimate Sliding Patio Door installation instructions.




25. Cut the length of the backer rod the width of the stationary panel(s). Insert the backer rod between the top rail and the head jamb. Notch out backer rod around head jamb bracket. See illustration 19.



26. Insert dust block end of stationary cover over interlock and slide into place. Fasten the stationary cover(s) into the head jamb with three #8X1 1/2" flat head screws "C" into the predrilled holes. See illustration 20.


NOTE: Four wide units will have two stationary covers.




NOTE: For three wide units, continue with step 27. For two and four wide units, skip to step 32.

INSTALLING NON INTERLOCKING STATIONARY PANEL (OXO CONFIGURATION)

27. Install exterior clad jamb part stops up tight against head jamb part stop. See illustration 21a. Install the non-interlocking stationary panel from the interior by tilting the panel inward and placing the bottom of the panel onto the top of the sill. Tilt the panel into a vertical position against the head jamb part stop. See illustration 21b. Press in interior wood jamb liners (bevel side toward panel) and secure the panel into place with three #8 x 3" flat head screws "B" through the predrilled holes in the side jamb. See illustration 21c.




28. Attach the wood panel guide (with its applied tape) to the three wide non-interlocking panel. Fasten with 1 1/2" (27) finish nail every 8" (203).



INSTALLING JAMB STRIKE (OXO CONFIGURATION)

NOTE: For all other configurations refer to *Installing Jamb Strike* in the *Ultimate Sliding Patio Door installation instructions*.

29. Remove the top shipping screw from the jamb strike. Hold a straight-edge against the center jamb and replace the screw with one of the supplied #8X3" pan head screws "E". Tighten the screw while sighting along the straight-edge to make sure not to bow the center jamb. See illustration 23.




30. Follow the same procedure to replace the remaining three screws.

NOTE: Adjustment of jamb strike may be necessary. See *Ultimate Sliding Patio Door installation instructions* for more information.

SCREEN TRACK INSTALLATION

31. Place the screen track up into the head jamb above the active panel(s) and interlocking panel(s). Fasten the track to the head jamb with #7X5/8" self tapping flat head screws "K" through pre-drilled holes in screen track. See illustration 24. The screen bumper is applied to the Ultimate screen only.



NOTE: The screen instructions will cover the proper installation of the screen onto the track.

32. Refer to the *Ultimate Sliding Patio Door Installation Instructions* to complete the installation and assembly of the door. The *Sliding Patio Door Installation Instructions* will include the proper installation of the inactive panel (for 4 panel doors), and active panel (for all doors) and will take into account the placement of the header guide with wood cover, the head jamb bumper block with rubber bumper, and the wood plugs included in your KD package.
